

As some other reviews of this Hornady Hndbk for Kindle have stated, the data charts are teeny tiny and not easy at all to resize on a P.C. or Kindle for P.C. application. But on an iPad (using the Kindle for iPad free applet) re-sizing is done with a squeeze of the fingers, just like any iPad ap. This makes the Kindle version very usable. Due to the re-sizing the data charts failure on my: Kindle DX reader, Kindle for P.C. on either a laptop and desktop, I could not recommend this book, except in the excellent printed version. For an iPad or Android tablet of sufficient size to read, highly recommended, and handier to pursue than the printed book.---One note for owners of the original iPad: the iTunes store will not let you download the Kindle Reader for IPad because the original iPad will not run iOs higher than 5.1 and the Kindle Reader for iPad requires a later (higher) version of iOs. But there is a runaround. And it works for any application that your original iPad cannot download due to the old iOs. As long as there once was an older version of the same Ap on iTunes. Using your regular iPad/iPhone user account log onto iTunes with a laptop or P.C., sign in and download the application to the PC. iTunes will allow you to download any version of any Ap onto a P.C.Next discard (delete) it. You don't need it.Next go onto to your iPad/iPhone and go to iTunes. Now (magically) you ARE indeed allowed to download any version of the Ap. iTunes will allow you to choose the older or newer version (whereas before it would not). So that now you can download the older version of Kindle for iPad that runs on the old iOS 5.1.
