

The main reason I didn't give the book five stars was the fact that they didn't go into the same level of detail where energy systems were concerned. It's possible to create your own solar panels and wind turbines, and these would have been HUGE additions to the book, IMO. Likewise, I'd have love to see some sourcing - ie, where you can go to get killer deals on solar panels with blemishes (no change in output, but you can typically buy for fifty cents on the dollar). All in all though, this is a great primer for someone who's interested in the topic but doesn't quite know where to start.
