

In the book he discusses: How to set up a rotation of pasturesWhich plants he prefers and ones that will do well in other climatesHow to graze the pasturesWhat problems specific pastures (plant type) might pose to livestockHow to cut pastures for

hay and silageHow to seed pastures with the minimum of equipmentHow to divide permanent pastures and temporary pastures (used for gardens, hay making, growing grains, etc.)How to build and maintain fencesStocking rates for animals (though this varies by region and quality of the soil)What plants to avoid in your pasturesWhich trees are good on pasturesGood and Bad weeds for grazingHow to make a haystackHow to build a reserve of plant material for winter grazingHow to approach year round grazing with minimal hay or grain feedAnd most importantly how to let the animals do most of the workThis book is aimed more at a garden farmer who is trying to maximize self sufficiency than the production minded market/commercial farmer. For commercial farmers who are willing to sacrifice some of the quantity for quality, then this book will work for you too. Most of the discussion is framed around farms in the 5-50 acre range. It is still helpful for those who will have less land for a few animals and is also scalable for farms in the 50-500 acre range. Gene is not anti grain , he just believes in planting it with other crops like clover and letting the animals harvest and feed it to them selves. Instead of 90% grain and 10% pasture he advocates for 80% pasture and 20% grain.
