

D.S. Fisher is one of the few who has the talent to draw his readers in by making the characters feel real, to the point where the affairs of each character influence the reader's own emotions. I fell in love with the characters and soon found myself unwilling to put the book down. The idea of the main character (Maddus) starting as an underdog but gaining the respect of the other soldiers is portrayed perfectly. Maddus also has one of the most interesting backgrounds I've seen in a novel, especially coming from only reading one book about him. One of the other interesting aspects was the ability to see the story unfold from multiple perspectives, often as characters were introduced. D.S. Fisher's writing style never seized to draw me in and amazed me. Maddus is probably my favorite character because of his unrelenting spirit.
