

Series editor Tim Folger collects candidate articles from general-interest periodicals such as the Atlantic and The New Yorker and more tailored publications like Scientific American, Popular Science, Orion, and the Virginia Quarterly Review and assures that the selections include a wide variety of science and nature topics. Each year he is joined by a different prominent scientist or science journalist, who makes the final selection of articles. As a result, each book has a fresh personality reflecting the guest editor's interests and intellectual bent. This year's guest editor, Siddhartha Mukherjee, is a cancer physician and the author of the Pulitzer-Prize-winning The Emperor of Maladies: A Biography of Cancer.
